2019 SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The following scholarships are available to all students who are pre-enrolled with Huntley for the 2019 academic year. These scholarships are provided by the Board of Trustees with the support of a number of generous benefactors of our school.

CLOSING DATES

- Applications for Huntley Academic, Boarding, Sport and Cultural scholarships close *1 July 2018*.
- Examinations for the Academic and Cultural scholarships will take place in July and recipients for all scholarships will be announced in *August 2018*.
- Applications for Scholarships received *after 1 July 2018* will only be able to be considered for the Headmaster's Scholarship.
- Applications for the Headmaster's Scholarship close *30 October 2018*. The value and recipients of these scholarships will be confirmed in November.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

If you are applying for a scholarship on the understanding that without funding your child would not be able to attend Huntley School, please submit the Financial Disclosure Statement with your application. This information will be treated in utmost confidence.

ELIGIBILITY

Please note – while you may apply for any scholarship – there will only be 1 scholarship awarded per student.



SCHOLARSHIPS 2019

BETTY MAYNE SCHOLARSHIP

The Betty Mayne Foundation was established by her son David Mayne, who is an old boy of Huntley School. The Foundation is to commemorate the life of Betty Mayne who became a widow at the age of twenty nine. She was left without family other than her sons aged seven and eight. It was her sacrifice that enabled her sons to go to Huntley.

The Foundation is to assist parents who suffer hardship or to help them give their children schooling at Huntley when this would not otherwise be possible. Grants made by the Foundation are gifts not scholarships or bursaries which are won and awarded on merit.

Preference is given in cases:

- When hardship is the result of sudden disaster, distress or anything untoward and unexpected; and
- Where families have a connection or relationship with Huntley or have shown an interest in the school and its philosophy.

The value of the gift is \$10,000 per annum for two years and is applicable to students entering the school as boarders in Year 7. The next award will be made for 2019.

The Foundation is administered by a Trust but expressions of interest should be made to the Headmaster in the first instance. If you are applying for a scholarship on the understanding that without funding your child would not be able to attend Huntley School, please submit the Financial Disclosure Statement with your application. This information will be treated in utmost confidence.

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

4 Scholarships - To be awarded to 1 student entering years 3-4, 1 student entering years 5-6, 1 student entering year 7 and 1 entering year 8 in 2019.

Scholarship value - \$2500 per year from the date the scholarship is awarded, subject to an annual end of year review of the child's academic effort and adherence to Huntley values.

Academic Scholarships will be awarded to students with outstanding academic ability and potential as demonstrated by previous school reports and an examination focused on English and Maths.

Eligibility

- Applicants must have completed an enrolment form for Huntley School.
- Applications are open to current Year 3 - 7 Huntley students.

Key dates

- Applications close 1 July 2018.
- Applicants will be required to attend English and Mathematics examinations at Huntley School (or remotely by arrangement) in July.
- Scholarship recipients will be announced in term 3 of 2018.

BOARDING SCHOLARSHIPS

3 Scholarships for \$4000 per year from the date the scholarship is awarded, subject to an annual end of year review of the student's effort and achievement across the 5 Huntley pillars and adherence to Huntley values

Boarding Scholarships will be awarded to students who demonstrate all round ability; leadership; and will strive to uphold the Huntley values as a boarder. The boarding scholarship may be awarded to students who require assistance in order to attend Huntley school as a boarder.

Eligibility

- Applicants must have completed an enrolment form for Huntley School.



SCHOLARSHIPS 2019

- A financial disclosure form is required to support all Boarding scholarship applications
- Only new students in 2019 are eligible for this scholarship

Key dates

- Applications close 1 July 2018.
- Shortlisted students will be required to attend interviews with the Headmaster at Huntley School in term 3 2018.
- Scholarship recipients will be announced in August 2018.

SPORTS SCHOLARSHIPS

3 Scholarships for \$2500 per year from the date the scholarship is awarded, subject to an annual end of year review of the student's effort and adherence to Huntley values.

Sports scholarships will be awarded to students demonstrating outstanding skills, commitment and potential to excel in one of the major sporting codes played at Huntley, which are:

- Rugby
- Football
- Netball
- Hockey
- Cricket
- Tennis
- Triathlon
- Softball

Eligibility

- Applicants must have completed an enrolment form for Huntley School.
- Only new students in 2019 are eligible for this scholarship

Key dates

- Applications close 1 July 2018.
- Shortlisted students will be required to attend interviews with the Headmaster at Huntley School in July 2018.
- Scholarship recipients will be announced in August 2018.

MUSIC AND CULTURAL SCHOLARSHIP

1 Scholarship for \$2500 per year from the date the scholarship is awarded, subject to an annual end of year review of the child's effort and adherence to Huntley values.

The Music and Cultural Scholarship will be awarded to a student who demonstrates outstanding talent and commitment to music and/or speech and drama.

Eligibility

- Applicants must have completed an enrolment form for Huntley School
- Only new students in 2019 are eligible for this scholarship

Key dates

- Applications close 1 July 2018.
- Applicants will be required to attend an audition at Huntley School (or remotely by arrangement) in July.
- Scholarship recipients will be announced in August 2018.

HEADMASTER'S SCHOLARSHIPS

The Huntley Headmaster's Scholarships are awarded to students with all-round ability and enthusiasm for learning and achieving in all aspects of school life. They may be awarded to students who require assistance in order to attend Huntley school as a day student or boarder.

Eligibility

- Applicants must have completed an enrolment form for Huntley School.
- A financial disclosure form is required to support all Headmaster's scholarship applications



SCHOLARSHIPS 2019

Key dates

- Applications close 30 October 2018
- Shortlisted students will be required to attend interviews with the Headmaster at Huntley School in November.
- Scholarship recipients will be confirmed in December 2018.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL SCHOLARSHIPS

For all scholarship applications please supply:

- A covering letter stating the Scholarships you are applying for
- A completed Scholarships checklist form
- Financial disclosure form if applying for the Boarding or Headmaster's Scholarships
- Your child's Huntley enrolment form (if your child is not already enrolled).

Your covering letter should succinctly describe your child's interests, activities and achievements in relation to the scholarship you are seeking.
